The Expo will be exhibit at Southmost College on September 20 and 21. All artists must exhibit both days.

Table: 6 Foot Table \$75.00 (includes 2 chairs); Half Table \$40.00 (includes 1 chair) Student Fee: \$30.00. Student ID is required. Two Expo badges are included (1 badge for a half table). No electricity provided. Booth standees cannot exceed 8 feet in height. Nothing may be taped, nailed or attached to the walls of the exhibit room. Bring your own tablecloth.

Payment must be made at time of application submission via Zelle or our PayPal account: larry@crearteexpo.com. Checks will be accepted if paid before September 12 with prior notice.

Spaces are confirmed only after receipt of payment. Tables and booths are limited and will be rented on a first-come first-served basis. You understand that filling out this application is not a guarantee of space.

RULES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The hours of the Expo are Saturday, September 20, 10:00am 6:00pm; Sunday, September 21, 11:00am 5:00p
- Exhibitors must attend their space for all hours of the Expo.
- Exhibitor setup is September 19 between 10:00 am 4:00 and September 20 (Saturday morning) between 8:00 9:30am; Sunday September 21 is Exhibitor take down 5:00 -6:30
- Please contact us if you require different arrangements.
- You must close and clean up your space during the take down period.
- The Expo is an all ages event. Exhibitors must show discretion with their displays and the materials that are presented. Please be respectful and courteous to your fellow exhibitors and attendees at all times.
- The CreArte Expo has the right to determine which exhibitors can participate in the Expo. Exhibitors with products and/or services relating to comic books, comic strips, animation, zines, jewelry, crafts and/or other related popular culture items are eligible to exhibit. CreArte Expo is meant to support the work of Latina/o/x creators, so we ask that applicants identify as such. No adult materials may be displayed or sold without prior written permission of the CreArte Expo.
- The CreArte Expo will assign all Exhibitor spaces at its sole discretion.
- The CreArte Expo makes no guarantees as to the number of people that will attend the Expo.
